DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE

REACH Declaration



- Eclipse MDI is committed to compliance with the EU REACH Regulation, (EC/1907/2006), regarding the registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction of chemicals. The following information is given to you to address communication obligations under the regulation, but does not establish a separate contractual relationship or modify any existing contractual obligations.
- Under Article 33, suppliers of articles have the responsibility to communicate to the recipients of their products, any substances of very high concern (SVHCs) contained in their products, above the stipulated threshold of 0.1%
- Obligations related to Article 7(2) on notification of substances in articles and Article 59(4) on authorisation of SVHCs are not applicable to Eclipse MDI products.
- As ECHA continues to update the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern, Annex XIV and Annex XVII, Eclipse MDI endeavours to collect information on the use of these substances from its suppliers. We ask our vendors to provide full material data about the constituents of the parts they supply and we manage that data across our product portfolio.
- Eclipse MDI has addressed the European Court of Justice decision regarding the definition of article in order to assure continued compliance with the legislation.
- On the basis of information provided to Eclipse MDI from its suppliers, certain products contain SVHCs above 0.1%w/w. We can provide specific reports for those products to comply with Article 33 requirements. We have also addressed our responsibilities under the EU Waste Framework Directive to submit SVHC notifications to the SCIP (Substance of Concern in Products) Database.
